

In recent years, we have taken great efforts to reduce the impact on the environment, and to also become more energy and cost efficient. Such efforts include the implementation of a full blown recycling program where we recycle all cans, bottles, paper products, cardboard, etc.

We have also been careful to select products that contain little to no toxins. An example of this includes the toxin free carpet that we installed in our new 7,000 square foot addition.

We also switched to green cleaning products throughout. This includes our industrial floor cleaning and other products.

For publications, we have switched to recycled paper.

Water usage, we have cut down our usage by installing low flow faucets in all 60 showers in the family and volunteer buildings, and in the showers in the main building by the pool. We also switched the sink faucets to low flow throughout.

Lighting, we have switched to halogen, energy efficient throughout the family activity center and campus.

In the dining hall, we recently converted our paper products and plastic ware to biodegradable products.

And finally, but not least, we added a layer of Low-E reflective insulation throughout our entire family activity center this winter in an effort to conserve energy and reduce consumption. We feel this insulation will help us tremendously, especially as fuel prices continue to rise, and are incredibly grateful to Environmentally Safe Products, Inc. for their donation of this product.

While we are proud of our efforts thus far, we plan on continuing to seek out ways to become more efficient. We are currently looking into adding solar panels over the indoor pool in the future, and are investigating other ways to become more energy efficient.
